

## WEST ELEMENTARY BEFORE AND AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAMS

**L.E.A.D.**

**(Lead, Educate, and Dream)**

**The L.E.A.D. program is made possible through a partnership between Newcomerstown Schools and the Muskingum Valley Educational Service Center through the 21<sup>st</sup> Century Grant.**

Beginning Monday, October 5<sup>th</sup>, selected students will attend Academic Intervention classes from 7:00-8:25, which also includes breakfast. The L.E.A.D. after-school program will begin Thursday, October 1<sup>st</sup>. The morning program will run Tuesday, Wednesday, & Friday and will end May 14<sup>th</sup>. The exciting after-school program will provide snacks, reading and math intervention, inquiry based project learning and clubs and will be held Monday through Thursday beginning October 1<sup>st</sup> and will also end May 13<sup>th</sup>.

The schedule for the afterschool program is:  
2:45 – 3:25 – Check in, snack & gross Motor activity  
3:25 – 4:25 – Reading & Math Intervention  
4:25 -- 5:25 – Tues./Thurs. – Clubs – Mon./Wed. – Project Based Learning  
5:25 – 5:30 - Sign out and pick up.

**Why: The purpose of the before and after-school L.E.A.D. program is to support student learning & development in a safe and supportive environment. Studies show that students who regularly attend structured after school activities have higher achievement and attendance rates.**

### **Where:**

Morning Intervention – Students are to come in the main entrance to be checked in and will go directly to their classrooms. After Reading or Math, they will then be escorted to the LEAD Room for Math and Reading games and then to the cafeteria/classroom for breakfast.

After-School L.E.A.D. Program – Students will go from the cafeteria and will be checked in. After all sessions, students will be escorted to the main entrance to sign out and meet parents at 5:15.

**How to Apply** – Please complete **both sides** of the attached enrollment forms. All forms must be due back to West Elementary School no later than **Friday, September 11th**.

### **Other Services offered:**

- Gas vouchers can be provided to parents who qualify for free meals. An application form will be sent home to all L.E.A.D. students. Please return it if you wish to check your qualification.
- In addition, Danelle Kilpatrick, Family Liaison will work closely with parents providing them help with student attendance at school and this program, help parents with educational concerns and provide information and assistance.
